ALL ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES

1. **ENTRIES CLOSE** with Convenor on the closing date stated on the front of this schedule.
2. No entry will be accepted at all.
3. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED unless the section is withdrawn by the committee. A stamped business sized self-addressed envelope MUST BE included for return of appearance notices.
4. If, by the closing date, only one entry is received for a section, the entry may not be accepted unless the section can be combined with another section. If the entry is not accepted the applicant will be notified ASAP and the entry fee returned.
5. All competitors perform at their own risk.
6. All sections are open to amateurs only, except: (a) In the case of a Conductor or Accompanist (Please note special instructions in the primary school instrumental section). (b) General Music - Sections 304, 307, 334, 351, 352, 369, 383, 388, 404, 405, 406 and 407. In the Eisteddfod, an amateur is defined as any person whose main source of income is not derived from any exercise of their talents in the particular discipline for which they have entered.
7. In all sections which are subject to an age limit, the age as of January 1, 2025, shall be deemed the age of the competitor.
8. **Items can only be performed once in this Eisteddfod.**
9. Competitors are not permitted to perform an item for which they have previously won first place, in the City of Sale Eisteddfod.
10. **Choir stands have a maximum capacity of 50.**
11. Competitors are not to appear more than once in any one Section; other than in Music sections where a competitor may be a Bona Fide member of a Band, Orchestra OR Ensemble, or a Special Choir and a Grade/Year Choir.
12. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Adjudicator, whose decision will be final. Prizes may be withheld where, in the opinion of the Adjudicator, sufficient merit has not been shown.
13. Competitors must report to the Secretary's desk at least 15 minutes prior to commencement of their section.
14. **Competitors are to supply a clear copy of their music. Failure to do so will see the competitor perform for critique sheet only. ALL BARS OF MUSIC FOR THE ADJUDICATOR MUST BE NUMBERED.**
15. Competitor and/or accompanist must use original copies of music or authorised photocopies (where photocopies are used they must be accompanied by a letter from the publisher or copyright holder). **Schools must use "AMCOS" stamped copies in accordance with "AMCOS" agreement if original copies not provided.**
16. Unauthorised photocopies submitted for adjudicators will be destroyed immediately after adjudication.
17. All competitors are required to comply with the booklet "Guidelines To Copyright" available from AMCOS (Australasian Mechanical Copyright Owners Society), 6-12 Atchison Street, St. Leonards, NSW 2065. Telephone: 02 9935 7900. FAX: 02 9935 7999. Email: print@amcos.com.au or info@amcos.com.au. These rules are in accordance with the directions of the Australian Copyright Agencies Ltd. and NO variations will be permitted.
18. Communication with the adjudicator, during the Eisteddfod, is not permitted by parent, teacher, or competitors, excluding committee members. Enquiries are to be made through the Desk Secretary or Session Chairperson.
19. No prompting or assistance of any kind may be given by teachers or other interested parties during the competition. The adjudicator or convenor are the only people permitted to prompt performers.
20. All competitors, conductors and accompanists are requested to wear suitable attire for presentation. The adjudicator may deduct points if dress is unsuitable.
21. **ALL TIME LIMITS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Performers exceeding these limits **will** have marks deducted at the adjudicator's discretion. Music section groups have 5 minutes to set up and begin performing.
22. A music stand will be supplied for soloists. Groups and bands should provide their own.
23. Excluding guitar sections and Section 319, 320 & 324, microphones and backing tapes/CDs are not permitted.
24. **ONLY PIANO OR GUITAR ACCOMPANIMENT MAY BE USED FOR SOLOS, DUETS, TRIOS AND QUARTETS** in **General Music** section, unless prior approval has been sought from the committee.
25. Accompanists cannot sing with a solo.
26. A piano is available for accompaniment but you **must arrange your own pianist**.
27. Competitors are to collect the Adjudicator Reports and Certificates by the closure of each session. These are available, 15 minutes after the completion of a section, from the Secretary's desk.
28. Any protest must be made in writing within 15 minutes of completion of the section and be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed. **The decision of the Committee in all matters will be final.**
29. The Committee reserves the right to amend the program at any time by changing the order of the competitors. The Committee has the right to combine or remove sections where insufficient numbers enter.
30. The Committee reserves the right to appoint another adjudicator should the occasion arise.
31. It is an infringement of copyright law to use cameras and video cameras or recording equipment. These are strictly prohibited. MOBILE PHONES MUST BE TURNED OFF BEFORE ENTERING VENUE.
32. The Eisteddfod will be run in accordance with our COVID Safe Plan (which will be distributed closer to the event and updated as needed) and will adhere to all current health advice and rules at the time running. Please be prepared that things may change last minute and entrants will be advised accordingly and expected to comply with all protocols as necessary while in attendance of the Eisteddfod. In the event of a Government Restricted Cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less the administration fee.

- **A generic running sheet of sections will be emailed to you once entries are finalised.**
